The school offers a 15% discount/sibling rebate on registration and tuition fees for 2nd and 3rd child enrolling from the same family.

School Outings

School outings costs (e.g. venue entry & transport) are not included in the school fees. Outings costs and transport for each individual outing vary. Parents will be informed by the specific teacher, who arranges the outing, of the costs and the parent must pay the outing costs in **CASH** to the responsible teacher.

Primary School Aftercare Fees 2025

Hours: 14:30 to 17:30 during the term only. Hours during exam time: 13:00 to 17:30.

R1,715 x 11 months instalments; R18,865 is the annual amount (as per the number of school days in the year = 196 in 2025).

Aftercare Fees are invoiced in advance of the month and are due no later than the 1st of the month).

Aftercare Fees are not refundable should a student not make full use of the facilities. One month written notice is required for withdrawing a child from aftercare.

School Development Levy (SDL)

Non-refundable School Development Levy:

In addition to Annual School Fees, Academy Private School applies a R1,500 Annual Development Fee. This Development Fee is raised annually from the pupil's second and each subsequent year of enrolment. The purpose of the fee is to be used exclusively for Academy Private School capital projects and to enhance the facilities of the school. Parents will be invoiced annually and this fee is payable by 1 January.

Note: School Development Levy is not applicable to Grade R and is not charged the year the child moves to Grade R in his second year at the school.

Admission Policy for Current Students

Admission Deposit:

All current parents must obtain an **Academy Private School Fees Schedule Form** from the school office for your child for the next year to complete, sign and return to the school as well as pay the admission deposit **by 30 September**. The **Admission Deposit** is R1400. The admission deposit is non-refundable should your child leave the school after **30 September**, as this deposit books your child's place in the class next year and we turn away other students who want to enrol. The admission deposit goes towards the next year January school fees. The payment of the admission deposit ensures your child's admission to the school next year. We receive advance enrolments (sometimes 2 and 3 years in advance) for grades which may result in a waiting list. Once we receive your admission deposit we will put your child on the appropriate grade list for next year.

E.g. January month school fees will be as follows: January school fees less R1400 due by 1 January.

I.T. Equipment

- **All Academy Private School high school (grades 7 to 12) students are required to have a Chromebook Laptop** which will be used daily in the classrooms for lessons.
- **Chromebook Laptop with eTextbooks loaded:** Academy Private School joined the eRevolution way back in 2014! All class textbooks (for high school students grades 7 to 12) will only be available as ebooks and used in the classrooms. The prescribed Chromebook laptop must be purchased by parents from the suggested online IT store. Parents must purchase the relevant etextbooks online and **they must ensure the etextbooks are loaded onto the Chromebook.**
- Parents must ensure that their child's Chromebook, and all other belongings of value are **INSURED** at all times.

Creative & Cultural Activities

Our school's creative and cultural enrichment activities are aimed at developing the "whole" child and it is our intention to focus on a holistic approach in this development. Students have the opportunity to join one or more creative clubs to showcase further talents and may even participate in and study these activities formally while enrolling for examinations, eisteddfods, etc. Some examples of enrichment activities that may be offered include: art, drama, dance, music e.g. choir, recorder, etc. The enrichment activities that are offered by our teachers during the formal school day are included in the school fees. Enrichment activities are offered depending on the interest and the minimum group numbers are met.

Creative & Cultural Activities Fees

Academy Creative Enrichment – Cultural & creative enrichment activities offered during the school day by our teachers are included in the school fees. Some activities require fees to be paid for competitions, transport, equipment, instruments, etc.

Activities that are offered by outside instructor/specialized coaches require monthly fees to be paid. e.g. Karate, Competitive Chess, Music Instruments such as guitar, drum kit, Soccer Stars, Rugby Skills, Little Cooks, etc. Activities and Clubs are offered depending on the demand and the minimum number of participants is met.

Sports – Extramurals

Sports are offered in the afternoons after school 14:45 to 15:45. Regular termly sports offered by our teachers are included in the school fees. Transport is not included. Transport must be paid by the parent/s. Sports are offered depending on the demand and the minimum numbers are met.

Examples of sports offered currently: Chess, Basket Ball, Five-a-side soccer (coaching is free, see other costs below), Running Club, etc.

Examples of Sports/Activities offered that require a monthly fee to be paid:

1. Five-a-side Soccer: Practice 1 day during the week and game/match on a Friday (court fees, game fees and transport to be paid as well as team kit must be purchased).
2. Karate
3. Soccer Stars
4. Musical Rascals/Djembe Beatz Drumming
5. Rugby Skills
6. Chess: Competitive Group
7. Mountain Biking (MTB) (League fees, competition fees, bike maintenance, trail permits, team kit)
8. Little Cooks
10. Individual Music lessons
9. Robotics Club fees to be paid
11. Tennis: Expert coach

Extramural sports and cultural activities/clubs are available depending on demand per term. Sports and cultural activities that are presented by external instructors require a monthly fee to be paid as well as activities which require materials, specific equipment, match transport and court fees, etc. E.g. Photography, robotics, music instruments (guitar, piano), acting/drama classes, karate, ballet require the payment of fees.

General Terms & Conditions

1. The Application and Registration/Acceptance fee is non-refundable.
2. **Each month's tuition fees are payable in advance**, free of exchange, deduction or set off **on or before the first day of each month**. Non-payment shall entitle the Director/s to cancel the enrolment of the pupil forthwith. Overdue payments shall accrue interest compounded monthly.
3. The school reserves the right to restrict admission of any pupil in respect of whom monies to the school are outstanding.
4. The school reserves the right to withhold student school reports and exam results whose school accounts are not paid up at the end of school terms.
5. **One term's notice, in writing**, is required when withdrawing a student from the School. A term's notice will be charged to accounts on immediate withdrawal.
6. All payments received will be applied firstly to the reduction of interest, legal fees and fees in lieu of notice, sundry charges and arrears applicable and then to the reduction of current tuition fees.
7. In the case of a parent, guardian, or person responsible for the payment of fees being sequestered and there are arrears fees, the student's attendance at the school will be immediately suspended. The student's continued attendance will be subject to all fees being paid in advance.
8. Sundry charges that will be charged: photocopying, outings, enrichment and cultural lessons, printing, telephone calls, laundry and certain activities where outside facilitators are paid to do presentations, etc.
9. Although school management will always endeavor not to increase tuition fees during the school year, it reserves the right to do so if circumstances require it. Increases in fees can reasonably be expected each year to provide for inflation and other costs.
10. Late **payment charge** will be levied at the rate of 15% on all accounts not settled by due date (1st of the month). Annual fees not paid in full by the 1st January and monthly fees not paid by the 1st day each month will be regarded as overdue.
11. Academy Private School is a "**cash free**" zone, parents are kindly requested not to pay any fees in this manner. **We reserve the right to recover cash deposit fees incurred.**

12. The Director may in his/her sole discretion grant refunds and make changes or adjustments of fees and other charges and shall give one term's written notice thereof.

13. The Director shall be entitled to instruct the academy's attorneys to attend to the collection of outstanding accounts and both parents (whether natural, adoptive or foster parents) shall be jointly and severally liable for the payment of all costs so incurred, on the scale as between attorney and own client, including collection fees.
